

## **GETTING TO WOODSTOCK FARM BY BIKE**

### **Biking Directions from the North Chuckanut Trailhead parking lot via the Interurban Trail, for Experienced Cyclists.**

- Biking to the site via California Street, the Interurban Trail and Spokane Street can be pleasant and avoids the narrow part of Chuckanut Drive but follows a steep, physically challenging route for many, and one which requires crossing Chuckanut at Spokane Street to reach the Woodstock driveway.

**DIRECTIONS:** Proceed south from the parking lot up California Street to the Interurban Trail/California Street intersection. Turn right on the Interurban Trail (which looks like a narrow road) and proceed to Spokane Street. Turn right on Spokane Street and then right or north on Chuckanut Drive a few feet to the Woodstock driveway on your left.

### **Biking Directions via Chuckanut Drive, for Experienced Cyclists.**

- Biking directly to the site along Chuckanut Drive (State Route 11) is commonplace but first-time highway bicyclists are advised that there are two places south of California Street where the highway approaching Woodstock is narrow and there is no shoulder.

**DIRECTIONS:** Proceed south on Chuckanut Drive past Lake Samish Road, the North Chuckanut Mtn. Trailhead and California Street, all on your left. Turn right into the first open driveway at the brown and white “Woodstock Farm” sign, just after several small mailboxes and a larger, yellow mailbox labeled “1200 Chuckanut North.”
