

GETTING TO WOODSTOCK FARM BY FOOT

- **Most of the Woodstock grounds are now open to walk-in and bike-in visitors during daylight hours. Please observe the signs located on site. The buildings, lower meadows and sheep pastures are often closed except by special arrangement or when signed otherwise.**
- **Private vehicles are allowed on site by permit only--when Parks Department staff support is available.** (See '[PERMITS](#)' for more information about automobile and group access permits.)
- At present walking to the site is recommended only via the Interurban Trail. **DO NOT WALK ALONG CHUCKANUT DRIVE.**

Walking Directions from the North Chuckanut Mtn. Trailhead (See [MAP](#)). Proceed south from the parking lot, either up California Street or via the foot trail just east of it to the Interurban trail/California Street intersection. Turn right on the Interurban Trail (which looks like a narrow road) and walk to Spokane Street. Turn right on Spokane Street and then carefully cross Chuckanut Drive and proceed north a few feet to the Woodstock driveway. Walkers are and must be advised that the shoulder along the Woodstock frontage becomes very narrow between Spokane and the Woodstock driveway—single file only, against the guardrail! (A new, less steep and more direct trail below Chuckanut Drive is anticipated but will not be completed for 2 or more years.)
