

## **CONNELLY CREEK TRAIL**

### **TRAIL DESCRIPTION**

Flat terrain along Connelly Creek through wooded canopy and open meadows.

### **TRAILHEADS**

Limited parking on gravel shoulder at the south access on Donovan Ave. at 30<sup>th</sup> St. North access is on Ferry Ave. east of Sehome High School near Bill McDonald Parkway. Follow the sidewalk on the south side of Donovan west for one block to Happy Valley Park where the trail continues south to Old Fairhaven Parkway. There are numerous neighborhood access points.

### **MILEAGE**

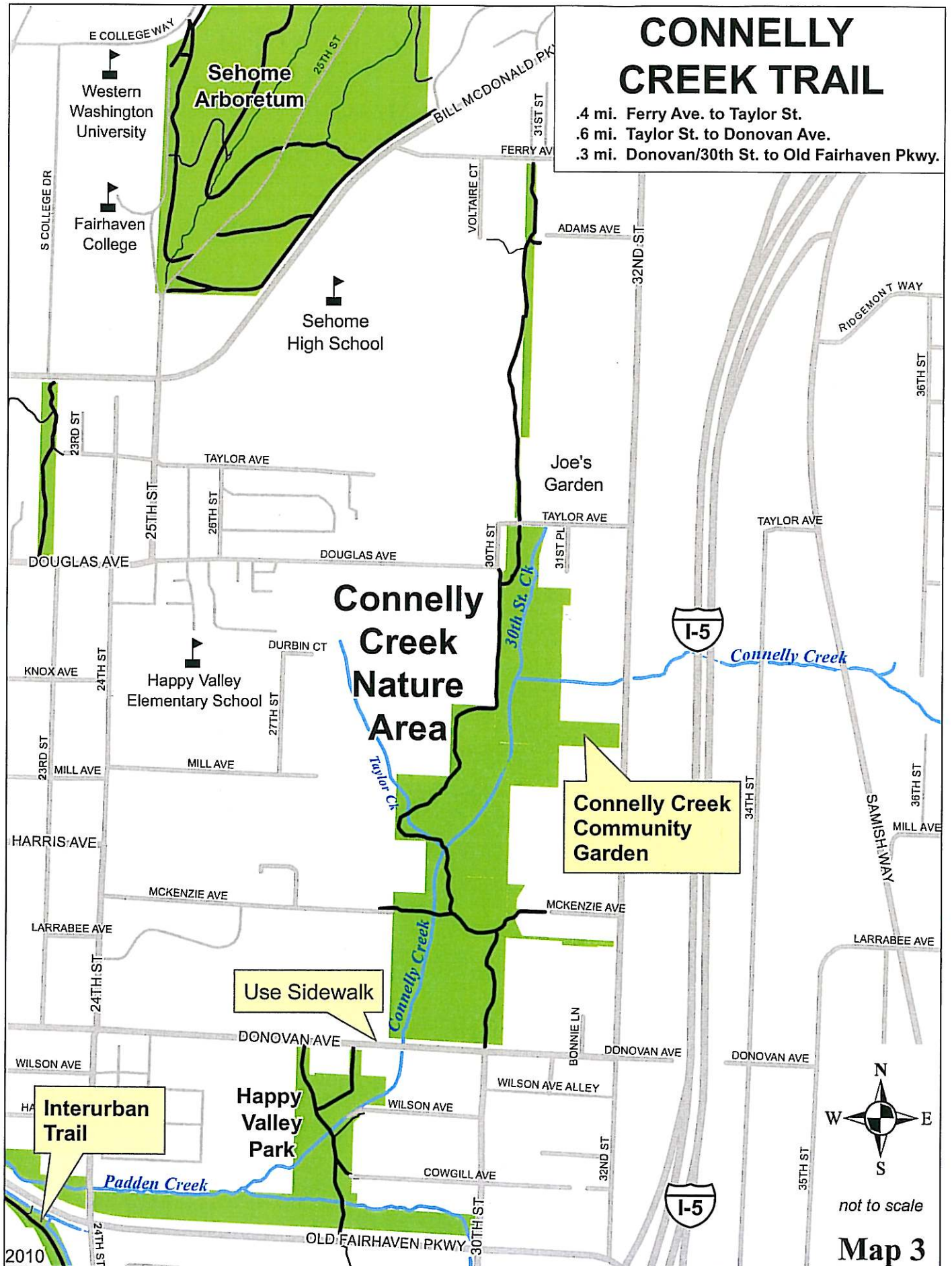
- 1 mile - Ferry Ave. to Donovan Ave.

**Connelly Creek Nature Area** was established in 1981. Some of the largest Sitka Spruce trees in the city are found near the creek.

**Happy Valley Park** is a neighborhood park established in 1995. Facilities include playground, picnic table and trails.
