South/uphill on trail or California St.

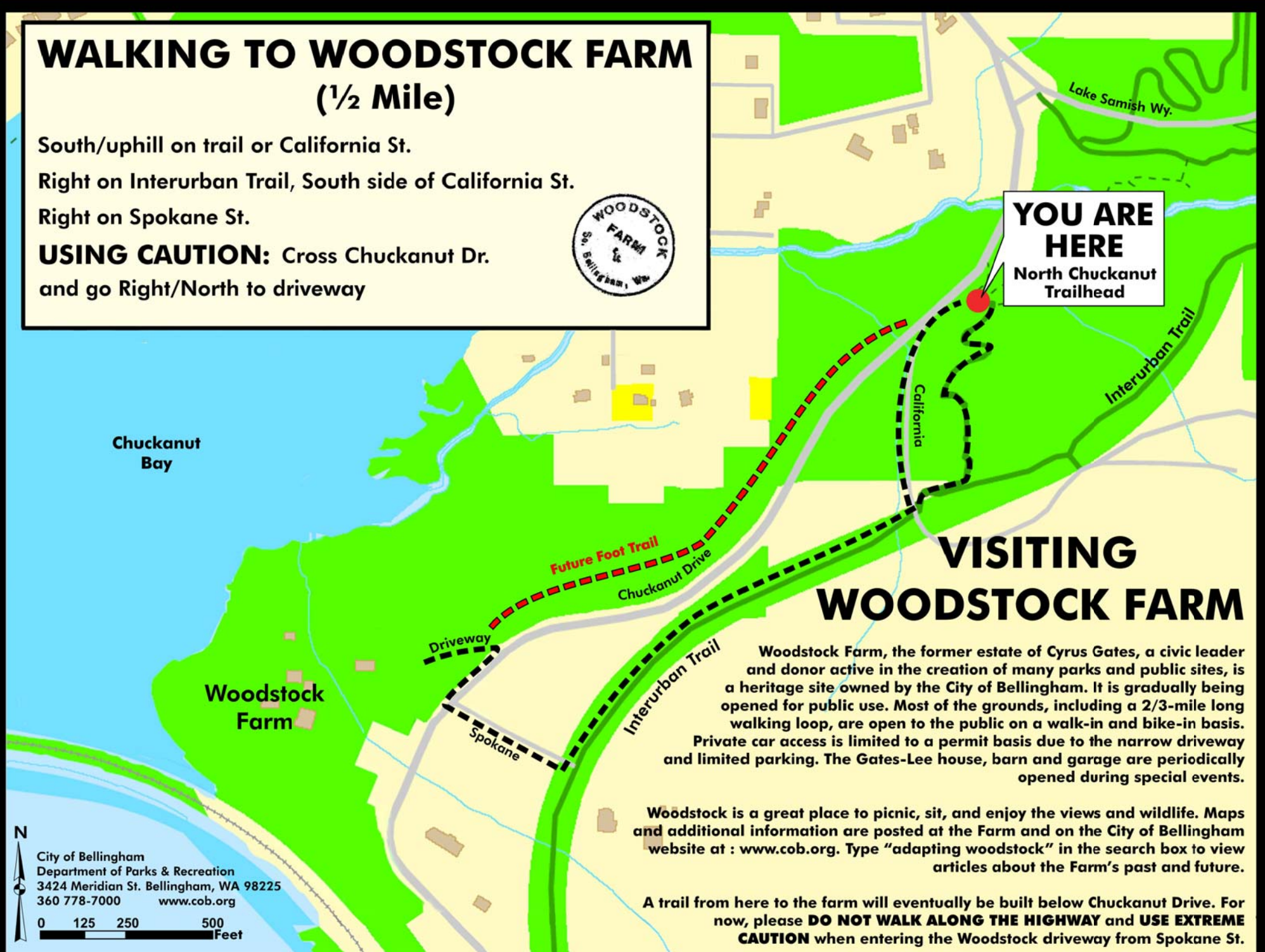
Right on Interurban Trail, South side of California St.

VISITING WOODSTOCK FARM

Woodstock Farm, the former estate of Cyrus Gates, a civic leader and donor active in the creation of many parks and public sites, is a heritage site owned by the City of Bellingham. It is gradually being opened for public use. Most of the grounds, including a 2/3-mile long walking loop, are open to the public on a walk-in and bike-in basis. Private car access is limited to a permit basis due to the narrow driveway and limited parking. The Gates-Lee house, barn and garage are periodically opened during special events.

Woodstock is a great place to picnic, sit, and enjoy the views and wildlife. Maps and additional information are posted at the Farm and on the City of Bellingham website at : www.cob.org. Type "adapting woodstock" in the search box to view articles about the Farm's past and future.

A trail from here to the farm will eventually be built below Chuckanut Drive. For now, please **DO NOT WALK ALONG THE HIGHWAY** and **USE EXTREME CAUTION** when entering the Woodstock driveway from Spokane St.
