



TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEES (TIF) WILL DECREASE SLIGHTLY IN 2012

On the afternoon of Monday, December 5, 2011, the Bellingham City Council will discuss a Resolution to establish the 2012 TIF base rate at **\$1,912** per p.m. peak vehicle trip, effective Monday, January 2, 2012. This is a slight decrease from the 2011 TIF base fee of \$1,927 per p.m. peak vehicle trip.

Transportation Impact Fees (TIFs) are charged to recover the costs of providing new transportation infrastructure and new development is charged a proportional share amount to help pay for the transportation infrastructure needed to serve the traveling public in Bellingham.
