









2008 Enhanced Buffer Plan Highlights

- Over 40 acres of preserved natural areas
- Plus seven acres of parks and open space
- Enhanced wetland buffers
- Avoids steep slopes
- Low-impact storm water management protects wetland hydrology
- Maximum five floor building height



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April 2005 Plan Highlights
