Sunset Drive Phase II

Vehicle and pedestrian improvements from
Woburn Street to Bellingham city limits (McLeod Road)

The Project

The City of Bellingham will be improving vehicle and pedestrian facilities on East Sunset Drive from Woburn Street to the city limits. The Sunset Phase II improvements will include adding driving lanes, a two-way left-turn lane, bicycle lanes, bus pullouts, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, enclosed drainage and street lighting. The project will reduce traffic congestion and complete a missing link in the bicycle and pedestrian network between Sunset Avenue, Woburn Street and McLeod Road (leading to Squaticum High School).

Next Steps

The project has been on the City's Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program since 1996, waiting for funding. If all goes as scheduled, the project will begin in early August and is expected to take a year to complete.

The public is invited to attend an open house regarding upcoming construction to Sunset Drive from Woburn Street to McLeod Road (Sunset Phase II). The open house will be held on Tuesday, July 29, from 5:00 to 7:30 P.M. in the Multipurpose Room at Bloedel Donovan Park. Final plans will be available and attendees will have an opportunity to meet the contractor, city staff, and design consultant, who will answer questions regarding the project, including the construction schedule.
