## Lake Whatcom Watershed Land Acquisition & Preservation Program Charge

Effective January 2001, the City Council approved an increase to water use rates to fund land acquisition and other land preservation measures in the Lake Whatcom Watershed to help preserve water quality. This watershed fee is in addition to flat/base rates above and is charged to all water customers.

Duplex .....	\$117.18

## STORMWATER

Small Footprint .....	\$8.40
Medium Footprint .....	\$14.00
Impervious Surface *Greater Than 3000 sq.ft. ....	\$.004666

per sq.ft. total impervious surface
