

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM SPONSORING THE BELLINGHAM PUBLIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY'S REQUEST TO JOIN THE ASSOCIATION OF WASHINGTON CITIES EMPLOYEE BENEFIT TRUST.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.21.730 through 35.21.755, the City Council of the City of Bellingham, Washington (the "City") authorized the creation of a public corporation as a separate legal entity to perform any lawful public purpose or public function as therein authorized; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Ordinance No. 2008-05-047 (the "Ordinance"), the City granted the Bellingham Public Development Authority's (the "Authority") charter (the "Charter") thereby creating the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Bellingham Public Development Authority would like to participate in the Association of Washington Cities ("AWC") Employee Benefit Trust benefits program as a quasi-municipal entity, but such participation requires sponsorship by a city member of the AWC Employee Benefit Trust before the quasi-municipal entity can participate;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM:

The City of Bellingham hereby sponsors the Bellingham Public Development Authority's request to join the AWC Employee Benefit Trust as a quasi-municipal entity; and


To that end, the City of Bellingham respectfully requests that the Bellingham Public Development Authority be granted membership in said AWC Employee Benefit Trust.
