

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-42

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING NEW AND UPDATED FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONAL PERMIT, PLAN REVIEW, AND INSPECTION FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, BMC 17.20.020 requires the City to establish fire permit and inspection fees by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the policy that permit and inspection fees shall cover the costs of providing such services and that these fees shall be periodically reviewed and updated to reflect the actual cost of providing these services; and

WHEREAS, the last update to Fire Department's Operation Permit fees was by Resolution 2005-41 on September 26, 2005; and

WHEREAS, fees need to be modified and created for operational permits, plan review, and inspections identified in BMC 17.20 and International Fire Code Section 105.6.

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the proposed fee schedules for fire permits and inspections as attached and finds they should be approved;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM:


The attached fire permit, plan review, and inspection fee schedules, as provided for in BMC 17.20.020 Section 105.2(b) are hereby adopted.



Permit Issuance

The fee is applied with the initial issuance of the Fire Operational Permit.

	\$120
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Permit Renewal

The fee is applied with the renewal of an existing Fire Operational Permit.

	\$60
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Operation Fee

The fee for each occurrence of an operation or process identified in International Fire Code Section 105.6

	\$30
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Category II Inspection

The fee for each occurrence of a Category II Inspection as outlined in the Fire Department Operational Permit Program.

	\$30
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Re-inspection

The fee is applied to a permit when such portion of work for which inspection is called is not complete, approved drawings and/or permit is not on site, or when the corrections have not been made by required date.

	\$120
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After-hours Inspection

The fee is applied to a permit for inspections made outside the Fire Inspector's normal work schedule.

	\$180/hour, two hour minimum
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Miscellaneous Service

The fee is applied to a permit for services provided where there is no fee specifically indicated.

	\$120/hour, one hour minimum
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Additional Plan Review

The fee is applied to a permit for plan review required by changes, additions, amendments, or revisions to applications or permits.
