
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM, WASHINGTON, REPEALING BELLINGHAM MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.52 WHICH CREATED A CITY TRANSIT DIVISION FOR THE CITY'S TRANSIT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellingham no longer operates City transit because this service is now provided by the Whatcom Transportation Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: Bellingham Municipal Code section 2.52 is hereby repealed.

2.52.010 - Created - Manager Appointment And Duties

A. There is created an administrative division of the City known as the Transit Division, which shall be under the supervision of a manager who shall have the duty and responsibility to provide the citizens of the City with safe, convenient, and timely bus service by doing the following:

1. Directing the operation of the Bellingham transit system;
2. Developing and maintaining accurate records on ridership by individual route and totals of all routes, to the end that such records shall be used to improve service;
3. Developing a long-range plan for equipment acquisition and replacement; and
4. Keeping informed on legislation, both state and federal, particularly in the area of grant programs, which may affect the City's transit system.

B. The transit division manager shall be appointed by the Mayor and shall serve at his pleasure.
