

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-05-032

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2009 BUDGET RECOGNIZING RECEIPT OF A \$50,000.00 PUGET SOUND PARTNERSHIP STATE OF WASHINGTON GRANT IN THE STREET FUND TO SUPPORT THE SILVER BEACH CREEK PHOSPHORUS REDUCTION PILOT PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL GRANT EXPENDITURES OF \$38,206.00 AND PLACING \$11,794.00 IN ESTIMATING ENDING UNDESIGNATED RESERVE.

WHEREAS, State Legislation has committed funds from the Puget Sound Partnership to support the joint efforts of the City, Whatcom County, and other project partners in implementing actions to reduce phosphorus loading in the Silver Beach Creek Watershed, and;

WHEREAS, this funding will be used for the first phase of a comprehensive program that will include education, on-the-ground stewardship actions, capital projects, monitoring, and enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:


The sum of \$38,206.00 is hereby appropriated in the Street Fund and the Street Fund Estimated Ending Reserve is hereby increased by \$11,794.00. The source of funds will be credited from:


