

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-08-057

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE 2009 BUDGET RECOGNIZING RECEIPT OF A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BYRNE/JAG RECOVERY GRANT TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$126,131.00 AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR RELATED EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$120,131.00 IN THE GENERAL FUND AND \$6,000.00 IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE FUND.

WHEREAS, the City has been notified that it will receive a U.S. Department of Justice Grant in the amount of \$126,131.00 to purchase equipment for the Neighborhood Policing Team, and

WHEREAS, funds from this grant will provide for the purchase of a digital forensics server that will be used as a central storage facility for forensic hard drive images, and

WHEREAS, funds also will be provided for the purchase of bicycles and uniforms for the Neighborhood Policing Team,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BELLINGHAM DOES ORDAIN:
