This rudimentary survey was designed to give the playground designers a general idea of what playground equipment is preferred by local school aged children. Each cell in the tabulation above contains the number of times students at Cordata Elementary School scored a particular piece of equipment 1, 2, 3, ..., to 10. For example, the tall slide received a rating of 1 by one scorer, a rating of 2 by three scorers, and so on. A low score means the equipment was preferred less than equipment with a higher score.
