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| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Mechanics Vehicle Permits (MVPs) must be renewed annually through Parking Services. The rate for 2018 is \$250.00 per permit.</li> <li>2) The permit is valid only while the vehicle is being used to provide ready access to tools and equipment. It cannot be used for employee parking adjacent to work sites.</li> <li>3) Each vehicle must have a decal or lettering of a permanent nature identifying the person, firm or corporation, prominently affixed to some portion of the exterior of the vehicle. Permits are transferable only between vehicles bearing the same logo.</li> <li>4) The vehicles using the permit must be registered in the parking system. Failure to register the vehicle may result in a citation. The online customer portal is not yet available; its location will be provided when in place. Information will be available at <a href="http://www.cob.org/parking">www.cob.org/parking</a>.</li> </ol> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5) The applicant must be licensed and registered to perform plumbing, electrical, construction, refrigeration, repair or a similar trade within the City limits.</li> <li>6) The permit is not valid for parking in special zones, such as bus, loading or disabled zones, or where road closures are in effect.</li> <li>7) Permits may be used at metered spaces only for the time required to complete the work. The permit allows tradespersons to park without paying for meter time only while engaging in their trade.</li> <li>8) Failure to conform to the provisions above may result in revocation of all permits issued and forfeiture of any fees paid. Other fines may be assessed, including a misdemeanor charge and a fine not to exceed \$500.</li> </ol> |
