Subject: **Post Point Resource Recovery Project Update**

Summary Statement: The solids handling process equipment at the Post Point facility has reached the end of its useful life and needs to be replaced. Based on City policy for Climate Action and community feedback on various options, a digestion process with energy recovery is the preferred solution. The project team has developed and evaluated the cost of construction and implementation of a new solids handling process. Staff will provide a briefing on the project, including a high level summary of the cost of replacing the solids handling process (currently incineration) with a digestion based process. The project includes elements necessary to meet the goals outlined in the adopted 2018 Climate Action Plan.

Previous Council Action: **Approval of 2015-2016 Budget. Council Briefings on 10/24/2016, 4/10/2017, 7/24/2017, and adoption of the 2018 Climate Action Plan**

Fiscal Impact: **This action has no immediate fiscal impact. Costs associated with the consultant's current work are included with the contract and approved operating budget.**
