JOB SUMMARY:

Works with, and assists in turf related mowing, trimming, and edging activities in the Bellingham Park system. May work with a crew or independently. May be assigned to work the North or South mowing route.

SUPERVISORY RELATIONSHIP:

Responsible to Park Specialist – Urban Parks or other employees as assigned. Oversees extra labor employees, federally funded personnel, or volunteers as assigned.

2. Performs other horticultural activities, utilizing sound horticultural skills.
3. Performs manual labor such as digging, shoveling, raking, lifting, and pushing a wheelbarrow.
4. Operates a variety of automotive equipment including pickup trucks and mowers.
5. Operates and maintains a variety of shop and portable power tools.
6. Performs other duties as assigned.

- Ability to work outside in all types of weather.
