Vacancies on city boards, commissions, and committees offer Bellingham citizens opportunities to serve their community. There are a number of vacancies on City Boards, Commissions, and Committees.

Eligibility

Candidates must be current residents of the State of Washington, and have been so for at least three (3) years; must presently live within Bellingham City limits and have done so for at least two (2) years, unless otherwise specified; be a registered voter and a U.S. Citizen.
