Dear Mr. Stewart,

We are writing on behalf of our client, Greenbriar Northwest Associates, in response to your letter of June 17, 2009, which requested permission for James Luce to be present onsite during additional data gathering for the Fairhaven Highlands EIS. The only issue arises from the ill-advised and unpermitted "survey" conducted at the direction of the mayor's office earlier this year. You have previously made it clear that document was not appropriate for inclusion in the SEPA process.

We want to support a good EIS, so James Luce's participation in the July 7th site visit is acceptable so long as it is clear the rejected report remains rejected and that his participation has no impact on that rejection; only confusion can result from its utilization.



On a related issue, we are concerned about the lack of precise methodology relating to the characterization of wetlands, and we will want to discuss that with you in the near future.


