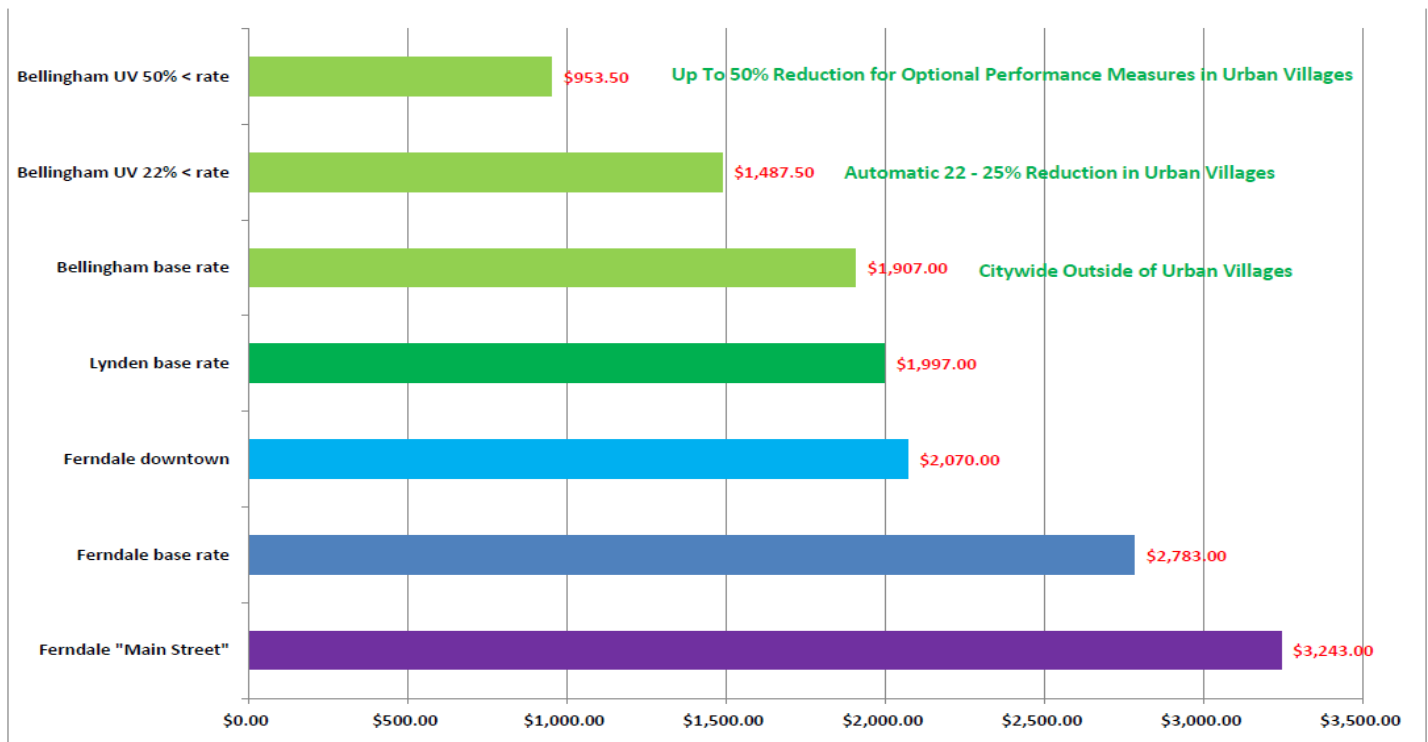




TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEES (TIF)
WILL DECREASE SLIGHTLY IN 2014

On Monday, December 9, 2013, the Bellingham City Council will discuss a Resolution to establish the 2014 TIF base rate at \$1,907 per p.m. peak vehicle trip, effective Wednesday, January 1, 2014. This is a slight decrease (- \$18 per trip) from the 2013 TIF base fee of \$1,925. Bellingham's TIF rate is low compared to most cities in western Washington and is the lowest of the three largest population centers in Whatcom County.
